Story of two Survivors ...by Gale Pritchett

It was New Years day 1998 and our beepers went off - there was a fire in the Wingello State Forest . Six of us (including Frank & I) set off to meet at the station to pick up the tanker. Shortly after arriving we were joined by David who took everyone down to a landing where we could put in a back burn to help prevent the fire from spreading if it came up the Gorge. Next, our Captain Mike arrived and insisted we leave as the wind had changed. Before we knew it, the fire came up the Gorge and hit the tanker with us all in it. It jammed our brakes so we couldn't move. It then hit us again melting windows and rubber. We had to get out! We all ran in different directions except David who had given up his life to save ours. He had placed the tanker in a position so as we could get out(2 doors away from the fire.)

Twenty two days later Frank woke up in Westmead hospital intensive care, whilst it took me two months and I was in North Shore Hospital. After 6 months we were transferred to Correbelle Rehab all whilst Frank with no fingers and only 2 thumbs and me being told I would never walk again.

It's taken time & patience but we are leading a rather normal and full life on our 18 acres with our pets and horses. We are very grateful to my son Simon & daughter Kim and my immediate family for all their support in our recovery. We are still members of the Rural Fire Brigade and on other committees including the Burns Support Foundation which we are very proud of. They had given so many people courage and support throughout the time we have been involved (approx 10 years) The camps that are held twice a year are very rewarding to those survivors and their families.


